### Remembrance Event: Saturday 10th November 2018

Many of you will have seen the poppies attached to walls and buildings in Caterham commemorating local servicemen who lost their lives in the Great War.

We are seeking student representatives to be involved in a poignant act of Remembrance on Saturday 10th November 2018 as follows: Young people of the Caterham community will come together at 9.30am in Manor Avenue, next to St Lawrence's Church on Church Hill. From 10.00am they will plant a named, replica poppy dedicated to one of the 220 local serviceman, within the church yard. It is anticipated that this will take around an hour, with the site being cleared of all schools and youth organisations by 12.00 noon.

Please bring in all bags on **WEDNESDAY 21<sup>st</sup> November** and leave them in the shelter in the front playground ready for collection at 9.15am. Please do not return the bags to school before this date, we do not have the room to store them. Thank you.
