Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

On Thursday, we were pleased to welcome Abigail Pedrick, from Pedricks Zero Waste Shop, who talked to the children in assembly about the importance of recycling.



At Hillcroft we are working towards our Green Flag Eco-Schools status, and one of our topics is recycling. We have been looking at different types of recycling including recycling plastic. Ecobricks are one solution for plastic. An Ecobrick is a reusable building block created by packing clean and dry used plastic into a plastic bottle to a set density. Abigail will be helping us with an Ecobrick workshop later in the year, we hope to make Ecobricks and collect enough to build a planter on the school field. We will keep you updated and let you know when we start collecting plastic and bottles to recycle.
