We have joined a very exciting campaign called the Big Battery Hunt.

The Big Battery Hunt is a nationwide battery recycling initiative funded by Duracell.

Young people in schools across the UK are encouraged to think about the importance of recycling, and then challenged to collect as many used batteries as they can. The aim is for each pupil to contribute to an overall total.

Each child has been supplied with a collection box and has been challenged to find and collect as many old batteries as possible. They can be as creative as they like by asking family members, by going to work spaces, places of worship, local businesses and the wider community to enlist everyone to help make sure that no battery ends up in landfill.

The Big Battery Hunt was launched with an assembly in KS2 which highlighted the importance of recycling. Please hand in all used batteries to the school office.
