Children are invited to wear their own clothes to school when they make a donation towards the Summer Fair. This year we are asking for:

Reminders:

- Please do not send your child to school carrying any medication. All medicines have to come via the school office and an 'Agreement to Administer Medicine' must be completed and signed before we can administer any medicine.
 - A lot of people are suffering with hayfever at the moment if your child takes any hayfever medication please give it to them before school. Please note we are unable to administer eye drops or medication unless it has been prescribed by a doctor.
- Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school. All school uniform should be named so that any lost items can be returned to their owner.
- Please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather, with a coat while the
 weather is changeable. When the warmer weather arrives please ensure you apply your
 child's sun cream before school. Children should also come to school with a sun hat or
 cap to wear while outside in the sun and a bottle of water.
- If you drive to school please may we remind you to park with consideration of our <u>neighbours</u>. Do not park on the bend, across the barrier of Hillcroft Court, in the loading bays of the shops in the Raglan Precinct or in the Doctors Surgery. There is a free public car park behind the Raglan Precinct, only a short walk from school.



Year 2 and Year 6 Assessments



Bird Box Project

The Schools Bird Box Project is an opportunity to stream and share live video of the birds that visit the schools nesting box. Our bird box is situated in the courtyard outside Chestnut Class. Friends of Hillcroft have paid our subscription again this year and the live stream to our bird box is now up and running.

To view the bird box log on to <u>www.seenature.org.uk</u> click on the live stream tab and then click on Hillcroft Primary School. All the schools that have a 'green dot' are streaming live. If there is no areen dot on the Hillcroft icon it will mean we are offline temporarily.

Before Easter the bird box was completely empty. There are now signs of a nest in there, but we haven't been lucky enough to see the bird yet. If you look at the other schools you will also be able to watch their bird boxes, they are all at different stages and some already have chicks in!
