To ensure the event runs smoothly within the time we are given, unfortunately we will not be allowing children to visit their parents during or after the races, and we kindly ask that you stay in the designated area for parents/carers at all times to ensure the children are in the right place at the right time with their teachers.

In addition to Sports Day, the children will get the opportunity to explore and develop skills in a wide variety of different sports to celebrate 'Sports Week'. This will involve a carousel of different activities and many other sports-related activities throughout the week.
