As a result, children in Year 1, Year 3 and Year 5 will remain in the same class as they go into their new class for September. This approach allows children to mix with different children within the same year group as they go on their journey through the school. I would like to assure you that much time and thought goes into the mix of classes and considerations such as ability, gender, friendships and general dynamics between children are deliberated. Once the class lists have been finalised, it is not possible to move children to the partner class.

#### **Bags 2 School**

We have a partnership with a company called Bag 2 School, which specialises in recycling good quality second hand clothing that can be re-used, and fundraising for the school.
