Geography


This term our curriculum school focus is Geography. Each year group has a different topic and they are learning about geography within that topic:








Home Learning

Reception class were expecting a visit from Millers Ark Mobile Farm this term. They visited us last year, providing a fantastic hand's on experience for the children.

During this unprecedented time, Miller's Ark have had to close the farm to the public and cancel all mobile farm bookings. As you can imagine their income has abruptly ended however they still have all their animals needing feed, veterinary treatment and daily care. They have been pro active and set up a Go Fund Me crowdfunding appeal (see link below) for anyone who can help and a subscription only newspaper to raise more funds.
