Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to thank you all for your support in attending the Christmas Fair this year and for selling raffle tickets etc. I am pleased to report that we made a profit of approximately £2,000 on the day so it was a successful fair and an enjoyable one.

The Friends of Hillcroft work hard behind the scenes to arrange events and raise money for the school so I thought you would like to know how we intend to spend some of this money in the near future.

As you know there is a problem with congestion at the front gate at drop off and pick up and this can be extremely frustrating. The Friends have been working with the school to try and find a solution to this problem and I am pleased to say that an agreement has now been found. On the 23rd of December a new gate will be installed in the inner railings. This along with the opening up of a second gate in the outer railings will mean that there will be separate gates for entering and leaving the school playground that comply with Health and Safety regulations and it is hoped that this will alleviate the congestion.

In the new year we will also be purchasing a bird nesting box which will be installed in the grounds.

This will be equipped with a camera and a live picture feed will be streamed to the classrooms. There will also be a web link for parent and children to check out the progress of any nesting birds at home. We will also be providing a mural and much needed new furniture for our school library.

All of this takes a lot of money and effort and without your support we would not be able to provide these and many other additional items and experiences that benefit the children. We are always looking for new ideas and in particular for volunteers to help us with our fundraising events. The more helpers we have the easier it is on everyone and the better our events will be. The Friends also have a say in how our hard earned funds are spent too.
