## Hillcroft Science Fair – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February

This term we are holding the first Hillcroft Science Fair. We invite all children to create a science stand, a display that shows their work attempting to answer a scientific question.

Their science fair entry should be displayed on a large piece of cardboard that can stand by itself, a recycled cardboard box is ideal. They can also make small models, handouts, or create demonstrations to support their project. All entries are due in on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January, then they will be displayed in the main hall for all the pupils and parents to enjoy at the Science Fair on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February – further details about visiting the fair will follow. The entries will be judged, and the winners of the competition across the year groups will go through to the GLF finals where they will showcase their displays against the other GLF schools.

The judges will be looking at:

**Planning** – is there a clear introduction? Has a question been used? Is there a prediction? **Investigative skills** – is there a clear method/ List of equipment? Diagrams?

Results – have tables and graphs been correctly labelled and used?

**Conclusions** – what was found out? How could it be improved?

Presentation - is it eye catching and exciting? Neatly written? Laid out clearly?

We hope many children will take part in the Science Fair and look forward to seeing their entries. It is a fantastic opportunity for the children to develop learning powers of curiosity, resourcefulness, designing their own learning, being adventurous and creative. We will be holding some lunchtime support sessions if the children need any support with their project.
