Thursday 28th September, the Science Technicians shared their lunch with a geologist and geophysicist and discussed the world of rocks while having a close look at fascinating samples. Kerry Henderson is an ambassador for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) at the University of Sussex and volunteers to share her knowledge with young learners. The children had plenty of questions for her; ranging from why she was inspired to become a scientist, to what rocks were beneath their feet.

The STEM Ambassador scheme is incredibly worthwhile, and inspires pupils to become interested in a wide range of subjects. As a result of the visit, the children were so enthused that they are planning a whole school assembly about the geology of Caterham and the surrounding area.

A good education gives a child the best possible start in life. We must ensure that all our children have an equal chance to make good use of the education that the school offers by providing a positive and encouraging atmosphere. To achieve this it is important that each child attends school regularly and punctually. When a child does not attend school regularly and on time they will have difficulty keeping up with their work and will therefore underachieve.

Research has shown that children with poor attendance:

- Find it harder to make and keep friends
- Are less likely to gain good qualifications
- Earn lower wages
- Have a higher chance of being unemployed
- Have low self-esteem

Children who miss school miss lessons. These lessons are not repeated, so children will have gaps in their learning. Additionally, often each day's lessons build upon those of the previous day – if a child misses a lesson they can miss the foundation to subsequent lessons. Children could begin to struggle and achieve less.

Attendance is related to achievement: The better the attendance, the better the achievement
